

## REANY

Clear a defensible space around your home.

Prepare an evacuation checklist of things to bring, including a Go Bag, important documents and animals.

Have an escape plan.





Build a kit.

Make a plan.

Have a communications plan.





Residents may be notified by phone or siren that evacuation is necessary.

Notify neighbors if possible.

Take your pre-made Go Bag and any pets or animals.

Safely make your way out of the area (see map other side).

#### **Most importantly:**

If you feel unsafe Do Not Wait, Get Out.



#### If you are unable to evacuate:

#### In your home:

- Stay inside until fire passes with windows and doors closed but unlocked
- Keep family together and remain calm
- · Remember if it is hot in your house it will be hotter outside

#### In your car:

- Park away from vegetation
- Roll up windows
- · Cover mouth with dry cloth to protect airway
- · Cover yourself with a blanket or jacket
- Stay in car until fire passes
- If car catches fire exit only after fire passes

#### On foot:

- · Find an area away from vegetation
- Lie face down
- · Cover mouth with dry cloth to protect airway

### **Returning home:**

You will not be permitted to return home until a safety inspection has been conducted for residual fires, downed power line and other hazards.

Information will be available through the media, at road blocks and shelters.
