LAWNMOWERS ON DRY VEGETATION CAN SPARK WILDFIRES



Think twice before undertaking any activities that may result in a fire.



5% of Wildfires are Lightning-Caused

95% of Wildfires are Human-Caused





TARGET SHOOTING SAFETY



Shoot in areas free of dry vegetation. Avoid shooting on hot & windy days.



Shooting at steel targets or rocks can spark fires. Use paper targets or clay pigeons.



Keep a shovel, fire extinguisher & extra water on hand in case a fire does start.
